### **Changes at AVC Since Accreditation Visit in Fall 2004**

- All 5 cabinet level positions are permanently filled (Only 2 were filled at accreditation).
- Former Dean responsible for the Library is now the VP Student Services.
- Instructional Resources (Library, Learning Center, IMC, GED) split among 3 Student Services Deans.
- Library reports to the new interim dean in charge of Admissions and Records/Counseling/Library & IMC.
- Revised/Updated Course Outlines of Record for 400 existing courses. 1100 more to do by June 2006.
- Academic areas and Student Services areas are on opposite sides of the flat/tiered organizational structure.
