The CCL Community College Library Award is presented at the CCL Annual Meeting to recognize a person who has made an outstanding contribution toward librarianship in the California community colleges.

Criteria: Nominees should have demonstrated significant achievement in one or more of the following categories:

- 1. Significant achievement in development and implementation of a unique and innovative library program or project.
- 2. Significant achievement in advocacy of library programs or services.
- 3. Demonstrated leadership in professional organizations that are associated with promoting the mission of community college libraries.
- 4. Participation and influence in library-related matters in the California community college decision-making arena.
- 5. Leadership role in developing goals and outcomes for community college libraries in the field of information technology.

Nomination Procedure:

Nominations will be accepted by the Executive Committee throughout the year; in addition, a call for nominations will be announced annually in the *CCL Outlook*. Nominations for the CCL Community College Library Achievement Award should include a brief summary of the nominee's contribution, a brief resume or curriculum vitae, and the names of three references who can be contacted for further information.
